Laptop/Tablet – Single Desk/Table	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Docking station with external monitor, keyboard and mouse • Adjust like traditional workstation
Laptop/Tablet - Mobile/Tabletops (conference rooms, hotels, coffee shops)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Portable stand • Travel keyboard (Bluetooth) • Bluetooth mouse • Adjust chair (or add cushion, when feasible) • May also consider Laptop desk for keyboard/mouse while laptop/tablet remains on tabletop • Backpack or rolling bag
Laptop/Tablet - Mobile/No Tabletops (airport, lounge chairs, vehicles)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Laptop desk • Use predictive text/text replacement/shortcuts to decrease keystrokes • Sit back in chair • Limit time in single sitting if unable to be in neutral • Backpack or rolling bag
Tablet/Smartphone – Holding device while using	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use headset • Smaller device: Pop socket • Larger device: g-hold microsuction, LoveHandle tablet grip, hand straps • Use digital assistant, speaker, dictation, predictive text, text replacement <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ iPhone – Settings → General → Accessibility → options for vision, interaction, hearing ○ iPhone – Settings → Keyboards → Text replacement, one-handed keyboard, dictation, predictive text
Save a few clicks with these 10 Excel Shortcuts Press and hold [Ctrl] while pressing 2nd key	<p>Hide Row = [Ctrl] 9</p> <p>Hide Column = [Ctrl] 0</p> <p>Copy from cell above = [Ctrl] ' (<i>apostrophe key</i>)</p> <p>Copy formula from cell above = [Ctrl] '</p> <p>Copy value from above (not formula) = [Ctrl] [Shift] "</p> <p>Open print preview window = [Ctrl] [F2]</p> <p>Move one screen to right = [Alt] [PgDn]</p> <p>Move one screen to left = [Alt] [PgUp]</p> <p>Move one tab (sheet) to right = [Ctrl] [Alt] [PgDn]</p> <p>Move one tab (sheet) to left = [Ctrl] [Alt] [PgUp]</p>
